# WHAT WE BELIEVE

Where Praise & Prayer meet Presence

We believe there is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory.

We believe in salvation by grace, a free gift of God to those who exercise faith in the only begotten Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, Whom God has sent in the flesh, incarnate, to die in a substitutionary way for the sins of all.

We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible and authoritative Word of God.

We believe in water baptism by immersion in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit for all who repent.

We believe in the premillennial Second Coming of our Lord Jesus Christ to resurrect the righteous dead and to catch away the living saints to meet Him in the air.

We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation.

We believe in the full working of the Holy Spirit in expressing His fruit, gifts, manifestations and callings as in New Testament times enabling the Body of Christ to live a Godly life, and perfecting the saints for the work of ministry.

We believe that power (anointing) or any other necessary quality can be passed from one person to another. The laying on of hands is practiced in conferring an office, to receive the Holy Spirit, to receive anointing or healing, to ordain consecrate, and to receive tools necessary for ministry.

We believe in the physical healing of sickness and disease through the power of God through the prayer of faith, often accompanied by anointing with oil and laying on of hands. It is provided for in the atonement of Christ and it is the privilege of every member of the church today.

We believe that through the grace and mercy of God we, as His sons and daughters, have become a chosen generation, a royal priesthood and a holy people made to show forth the praises of God. Every believer-priest has the right to go directly to God in Jesus' Name for his or her needs rather than rely upon a mediator-priest.
