# WHAT WE BELIEVE

We believe there is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory.

We believe in salvation by grace, a free gift of God to those who exercise faith in the only begotten Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, Whom God has sent in the flesh, incarnate, to die in a substitutionary way for the sins of all.

We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible and authoritative Word of God.

We believe in water baptism by immersion in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit as an outward public demonstration of the conversion that has already taken place in the believer's heart.

We believe in the Second Coming of our Lord Jesus Christ to resurrect the righteous dead and to catch away the living saints to meet Him in the air. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation.

We believe in the full working of the Holy Spirit in expressing His fruit, gifts, manifestations, and callings according to His will—enabling the Body of Christ to live a Godly life, and perfecting the saints for the work of ministry.

We believe in the physical healing of sickness and disease by the power of God. It is made possible in the atonement of Christ. One of the ways He may choose to do it, as shown in the New Testament, is by anointing with oil and laying on of hands.

We believe that through the grace and mercy of God we, as His sons and daughters, have become a chosen generation, a royal priesthood and a holy people made to show forth the praises of God. Every believer has the right to go directly to God in Jesus' Name for his or her needs, as well as the privilege to live a life led of the Holy Spirit, who indwells the personality of the believer and guides him or her to all truth in a personal way. The Holy Spirit is also responsible for illuminating the believer's understanding of scripture.
